Why attend a meeting?

The Tulare County Board of Supervisors' five districts are reviewed every 10 years based upon the new Census information which will be used to draw new boundaries.

These district boundaries define the political representation on the Board of Supervisors.

The Federal Voting Rights Act protects the interests of traditionally underrepresented groups in this process.
